Program of the Lessons

INTRODUCTION

During the last fifty years the international organized crime, searching as usual lucrative, illegal and non risky affairs, have infiltrated in sectors connected with the environment (rubbish discharge, production of building materials, reforestation, abusiveness) and the cultural property (commerce, forgery and looting of archaeological and historical objects). If the so-called phenomenon of the "archeo-mafias" torments all the nations rich in history and traditions, as shown by the experiences of manifold states (e.g. ex Yugoslavia, Albania, Algeria, Eritrea, Iraq, Afghanistan, Cambodia, Nepal, Mexico, Venezuela), it is particularly significant in the areas struck by political-economic crises or conflicts.

Also Palestine, because of the long-lasting "asymmetric war" against Israel, has seen in the illegitimate export of cultural property one of the main causes of the dispersion of its own archaeological.

The course about "Safeguard of Movable Cultural Property" draws attention to some basic practical and legal measures and tools to help combat illicit looting and trafficking in cultural property.

The Course will be articulate in 12 frontal lessons (24 hours) and in 2 training tours (6 hours).

COURSE AIMS

The course aims to increase the theoretical knowledge, technical skills and practical skills required to develop appropriate depth of understanding of issues in safeguard of movable cultural heritage. Students will undertake core topics in preventive protection and legal issues relevant to the movable cultural property.

The course draws on both theoretical and practical material and provides the opportunity for students to apply both the principles and the practical skills developed during the course.

Students will be equipped to:

- understand the diverse problems about protection of cultural property;
- understand major issues of safeguarding and managing interactions between visitors and heritage sites;
- undertake their work in an ethical way within the fields of protection of cultural heritage and sustainable tourism practice;
- understand and interpret international and national legislation relating to cultural heritage;
- enforce practical and legal measures and tools to help combat illicit looting and trafficking in cultural property.

CREDIT

Students who have successfully completed the requirements of the Course in "Safeguard of Movable Cultural Property" will receive, also, an attestation by "Observatory for Protection of Cultural heritage in Areas of Crisis" - 8 units of specified credit for the Italian Universities.
